DSCSA Enhanced Requirements Enforcement starts November 27, 2024

- The deadline to have interoperable traceability is November 27, 2024.
- Buyers must be able to receive and validate serialized data for <u>all</u> products purchased.



What steps Buyers should be taking today

- Ensure you have a solution provider that can receive and transmit EPCIS data for all eligible transactions from your pharmacy or hospital system.
- Contact your GPO or GS1 to obtain GLN registration information for all pharmacy locations and provide information to your solution provider.
- Contact your primary distributor and direct suppliers and obtain information regarding their 2024 plans to provide enhanced product tracing data (EPCIS-level data).
- Develop Policies and Procedures around DSCSA.





 Using Cervey's Verification tool is simple - just scan the product 2D barcode and validate the information is complete and accurate.






How Cervey helps you manage the new requirements - Product Validation



Common Questions and Q&A

- Q: What do I (the buyer) need to today to be prepared for the upcoming changes?
 - A: Obtain the GLN for your pharmacy and send it to Cervey.
- Q: Will I be required to scan every product that comes into the pharmacy?
 - A: No, the law does not state that the pharmacy is required to scan every product that comes into the pharmacy. However, Cervey is providing tools to scan products as needed based on each pharmacy's policies and procedures.
- Q: When does this go into effect?
 - A: The FDA delayed the enforcement of the DSCSA until November 27th, 2024. What this means is that by that date, every product coming into your pharmacy needs to have the matching serialized data or you will risk being out of compliance.
